Specialty camps are divided into three sessions each day. Participants may sign up for one or multiple sessions. During each session, instruction is provided in the indicated area.

INSTRUCATIONAL/DEVELOPMENTAL: Ages 6-14

This camp is designed to provide instruction in all aspects of the game. Participants receive instruction in hitting, defense, pitching/catching, baserunning, and strategy. They also participate in live and controlled scrimmages.

ALL STAR CAMP: Ages 14-18

This camp is designed for athletes who desire to play at the collegiate level. Participants receive information regarding NCAA academic standards, weight training, and the recruiting process. Players also participate in live and controlled scrimmaging, and receive instruction to improve hitting, speed, and arm velocity.

ADVANCED SPECIALTY: Ages 13-18

This camp is designed for high school level athletes. Each day features three sessions. During each session, instruction is provided in the indicated area. Participants may sign up for one or multiple sessions.

Participants receive instruction in hitting, defense, pitching/catching, baserunning, and strategy, and participate in live and controlled scrimmaging.
